REPORT

There was a response of 6 German stakeholders to take part of this national Info Day for presentation of project details and considerations of contents and possible impact.

In brief: the attending stakeholders (who did not belong to the NAG) found themselves, and their VET-organisations respectively, in the approach and the targets of this project. They all face the lacking competences beyond technical ones. Most curricula in Germany deal only to very limited extent, if at all, with soft and transversal skills. Only extra and special or optional courses support regular workers to build-up or improve competences like (internal) communication, presentation, customer orientation, delegation etc.

They supported the method of first detecting most important and valuable soft and transversal competences and then list them in a catalogue with learning outcomes to be developed. Also the approach to design particular courses as special or integral offers was highly appreciated by stakeholders.

There was a remark that not only workers and site managers should be addressed but also entrepreneurs as the deciding individuals for training and positions in companies.

All stakeholders confirmed to be included in the ongoing procedure of ConstructyVET and support this project where suitable.
